Bluegrass (Elite)	3	1 - 1 1/2	130	1/4"	Feb May	Aug- Oct 10	10-28	More disease resistance than common. Finer textured. Nicer lawn for aesthetic purposes.
Contractors Mix	6 - 8	3 - 4	260-350	1/4" - 3/8"	Feb May	Aug- Oct 20	7-28	Quick establishment. Coarse texture. Widely adapted to varying soils.

<b>Execu-Turf Executive Sun Mix</b>	5 - 6	2 - 3	175-225	1/4" - 3/8"	Feb May 10	Aug- Oct 10	7-28	Mix of 60% elite perennial ryegrass and 40% elite bluegrass for the Executive look.
Fescues Fine	4 - 6	2 - 3	175-260	1/4" - 3/8"	Feb May	Aug- Oct 10	10-21	Good shade adaptation. Fine textured. Excellent mix component.

<b>Execu-Turf Premium Shade Mix</b>	5 - 6	2 - 3	176-260	1/4" - 3/8"	Feb May	Aug- Oct 10	7-28	Exclusive shade mix for the discriminating homeowner. Will grow in most shade conditions.
<b>Execu-Turf Premium Sod Blend</b>	3	1 - 1 1/2	130	1/4"	Feb May 15	Aug- Oct 10	21-28	A blend of the best elite bluegrasses available in the marketplace.
